

The False Doctrines of the NIV Bible

All Scripture is KJV:

INTRODUCTION: WHAT DOES THE BIBLE HAVE TO SAY?

Today I would like to start outlining a series of false teachings that the NIV bible has caused, and show you how that Satan has been tampering with the Word of God to very successfully turn away many Christian believers from receiving the truth.

The changes seem subtle but have a very profound effect on the truth of God's Word.

✝ God said that man "must live" by every word that proceeds out of the mouth of God.

1. "Ye shall not ADD unto the WORD which I command you, neither shall ye DIMINISH ought from it,..." Deuteronomy 4:2.
2. "Satan cometh immediately and TAKETH AWAY THE WORD..." Mark 4:15.
3. Jesus said: "Till heaven and earth pass, one jot or one tittle shall in no wise pass from the law, till all be fulfilled." Matthew 5:18.
4. "If any man TAKE AWAY from the WORDS of the book of this prophecy, God shall take away his part out of the book of life, and out of the holy city." Revelation 22:19.

Matthew 4 King James Version (KJV)

1 Then was Jesus led up of the Spirit into the wilderness to be tempted of the devil.

² And when he had fasted forty days and forty nights, he was afterward an hungred.

³ And when the tempter came to him, he said, If thou be the Son of God, command that these stones be made bread.

⁴ But he answered and said, It is written, **Man shall not live by bread alone, but by every word that proceedeth out of the mouth of God.**

⁵ Then the devil taketh him up into the holy city, and setteth him on a pinnacle of the temple,

⁶ And saith unto him, If thou be the Son of God, cast thyself down: **for it is written,** He shall give his angels charge concerning thee: and in their hands they shall bear thee up, lest at any time thou dash thy foot against a stone. (Psalm 91:11-12).

⁷ Jesus said unto him, It is written again, Thou shalt not tempt the Lord thy God.

⁸ Again, the devil taketh him up into an exceeding high mountain, and sheweth him all the kingdoms of the world, and the glory of them;

⁹ And saith unto him, All these things will I give thee, if thou wilt fall down and worship me. ¹⁰ Then saith Jesus unto him, Get thee hence, Satan: **for it is written, Thou shalt worship the Lord thy God, and him only shalt thou serve.** ¹¹ Then the devil leaveth him, and, behold, angels came and ministered unto him.

✚ Satan came to Jesus and started quoting scripture out of context. That's what the NIV is doing.

✚ Yet Satan has come and changed what God said, just like he did in the garden of Eden, and also when he tempted our Lord.

Genesis 3 King James Version (KJV)

1. Now the serpent was more subtil than any beast of the field which the LORD God had made. And he said unto the woman, Yea, hath God said, Ye shall not eat of every tree of the garden?

² And the woman said unto the serpent, We may eat of the fruit of the trees of the garden: ³ But of the fruit of the tree which is in the midst of the garden, **God hath said, Ye shall not eat of it, neither shall ye touch it, lest ye die.** ⁴ **And the serpent said unto the woman, Ye shall not surely die: For God doth know that in the day ye eat thereof, then your eyes shall be opened, and ye shall be as gods, knowing good and evil.**

⁶ And when the woman saw that the tree was good for food, and that it was pleasant to the eyes, and a tree to be desired to make one wise, she took of the fruit thereof, and did eat, and gave also unto her husband with her; and he did eat. ⁷ And the eyes of them both were opened, and they knew that they were naked; and they sewed fig leaves together, and made themselves aprons.

SO NOW WE ARE GOING TO EXAMINE SCRIPTURE TOGETHER.

We are going to be examining every verse from what the NIV falsely says compared to the truth of God's Word from the KJV which is the very Word of God.

Starting in the OT.

Let's examine the scripture on what the NIV says about Jesus, compared to the KJV.

Error 1. Jesus Deity is Challenged.

Revelation 22:16-19 King James Version (KJV)

¹⁶ I Jesus have sent mine angel to testify unto you these things in the churches. **I am the root and the offspring of David, and the bright and morning star.**

¹⁷ And the Spirit and the bride say, Come. And let him that heareth say, Come. And let him that is athirst come. And whosoever will, let him take the water of life freely.

18 For I testify unto every man that heareth the words of the prophecy of this book, if any man shall add unto these things, God shall add unto him the plagues that are written in this book:

19 And if any man shall take away from the words of the book of this prophecy, God shall take away his part out of the book of life, and out of the holy city, and from the things which are written in this book.

- Isn't it funny that Revelation 2, says pretty much the same thing about false prophets, trying to change Gods word?

Revelation 2:20-25 King James Version (KJV)

20 Notwithstanding I have a few things against thee, because thou sufferest that woman Jezebel, which calleth herself a prophetess, to teach and to seduce my servants to commit fornication, and to eat things sacrificed unto idols.

21 And I gave her space to repent of her fornication; and she repented not.

22 Behold, I will cast her into a bed, and them that commit adultery with her into great tribulation, except they repent of their deeds. *(Spiritually adultery of Gods Word)*

23 And I will kill her children with death; and all the churches shall know that I am he which searcheth the reins and hearts: and I will give unto every one of you according to your works.

24 But unto you I say, and unto the rest in Thyatira, as many as have not this doctrine, and which have not known the depths of Satan, as they speak; I will put upon you none other burden.

25 But that which ye have already hold fast till I come.

- The emphasis God is telling us is to hold onto to his word until he comes.
- The false preachers and teachers, like the prophetess was changing Gods word into a lie (Joyce Meyers is one of these false prophets).

But what I really want to get into is the denial of the NIV that Jesus is God.

KJV Revelation 22:16 I Jesus have sent mine angel to testify unto you these things in the churches. I am the root and the offspring of David, and **the bright and morning star.**

NIV "I, Jesus, have sent my angel to give you this testimony for the churches. I am the Root and the Offspring of David, and **the bright Morning Star."**

- So far so good.....but.....lets continue to see where the NIV changes this.

KJV Isaiah 14:12

How art thou fallen from heaven, **O Lucifer, son of the morning!** how art thou cut down to the ground, which didst weaken the nations!

1. The KJV, says son of the morning. It does not mention anything about a star.
2. Yet the NIV says something completely blasphemous.

NIV How you have fallen from heaven, morning star, son of the dawn! You have been cast down to the earth, you who once laid low the nations!

1. The NIV says “morning star”. Yet this title is reserved for Jesus. Even in the NIV in Revelation 22:16 it says that Jesus is “the morning star”. Yet here it says that the morning star is referring to Satan.
2. The NIV is referring to the one that fell from Heaven. And who was that?
3. Was it not Satan?
4. So according to the NIV Jesus is none other than Satan!
5. The NIV does not even give mention to Lucifer in the NIV.
6. Even though Lucifer is referred to only once in the KJV.

But JESUS Christ calls Himself “the bright and morning star” in Revelation 22:16.

So the NIV by inserting “morning star” in Isaiah 14:12,

- a) Removes all mention of Lucifer as the devil’s personal name from Scripture.
- b) Blasphemes Christ by accusing Him as the One who weakens the nations. v.12
- c) Denies Christ’s deity by stating that Christ wanted to be like the most High. v.14
- d) Blasphemes Christ by predicting that He will be brought down to hell. v.15
- e) They change “hell” to “grave”, thus removing the warning against hell. v.15 f) Blasphemes Christ by saying that He has fallen from heaven. v.12.

Error 2. – on the Deity of Jesus

1. The NIV says that Jesus had a beginning. Of course that is Heresy. Jesus is eternal and came from Heaven.
2. Jesus did not have a beginning. It was Jesus who created the world we are in today as well as everything that there is, was created by Him.
3. Yet the NIV denies Jesus is eternal.

Micah 5:2 New International Version (NIV)

²“But you, Bethlehem Ephrathah, though you are small among the clans^[a] of Judah, out of you will come for me one who will be ruler over Israel, **whose origins are from of old, from ancient times.**”

1. So the NIV says that Jesus has a beginning.
2. That he came from ancient days.
3. That would mean he is from somewhere in history. That means, he came from time. That would mean he was created in time.

Micah 5:2 King James Version (KJV)

² But thou, Bethlehem Ephratah, though thou be little among the thousands of Judah, yet out of thee shall he come forth unto me that is to be ruler in Israel; whose goings forth have been from of old, **from everlasting.**

1. But the KJV says he is from everlasting, which means he had no beginning.

John 1:1

In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God.

John 1:2

The same was in the beginning with God.

Hebrews 1:10

And, Thou, Lord, **in the beginning hast laid the foundation of the earth; and the heavens are the works of thine hands:**

Ephesians 3:9

And to make all men see what is the fellowship of the mystery, which from the beginning of the world hath been hid in God, **who created all things by Jesus Christ:**

2. According to the KJV Jesus created the world and everything that there is.
3. But according to the NIV, it is not even mentioned in Ephesians 3:9.

Ephesians NIV 3:9 and to make plain to everyone the administration of this mystery, **which for ages past was kept hidden in God, who created all things.**

4. There is no mention of Jesus creating the heavens and the earth and all things. It just says God.

As we continue to challenge the error of the NIV on the deity of Christ, we continue to see the devil at work in this Satanic NIV.

1. The NIV in Luke 11:2-4 omits key parts of the LORD'S PRAYER.
 - ❖ The devil would not want us to pray these omitted words.
 - ❖ Matthew 6:9-13 in both KJV and NIV includes these omitted words in the Lord's Prayer.
 - ❖ NIV, NASB, etc in Luke 11:2-4: OMIT Father OMIT , hallowed be your name. Your kingdom come, OMITTED.
- ✓ Give us each day our daily bread. Forgive us our sins for we also forgive everyone who sins against us. And lead us not into temptation OMIT .

Our Father which art in heaven hallowed be thy name. Thy kingdom come. Thy will be done, as in heaven so in earth. Give us day by day our daily bread And forgive us our

sins; for we also forgive everyone that is indebted to us. And lead us not into temptation; but deliver us from evil.

Which "FATHER"? New Agers pray to another father which is not in heaven, but is the "god of this world".

- a) "Ye are of your father the devil". John 8:44.
- b) Satan likes being called "Father" because he wants to be like the Most High.
- c) "OUR" must be removed because it opposes the New Age idea of the "universal fatherhood of God".
- d) They think God is the Father of all people. They object to God being the Father only of Christians (John 1:12).
- e) "WHICH ART IN HEAVEN" identifies the Father to be worshipped as God in heaven and not the devil.
- f) "THY WILL BE DONE, AS IN HEAVEN, SO IN EARTH". The devil does not want us to pray that God's will be done on earth as it is in heaven.
- g) Hence it is omitted. "DELIVER US FROM EVIL". The devil doesn't want us to pray for God to deliver us from evil but rather he wants evil to come to us. Evil is too black and white.
- h) The devil doesn't want us to think about good and evil, heaven and hell. Hence he removes them from the Luke 11:2-4 Lord's Prayer in modern versions.

Luke 11:2-4 King James Version (KJV)

² And he said unto them, **When ye pray, say**, Our Father **which art in heaven**, **Hallowed be thy name**. **Thy kingdom come**. **Thy will be done, as in heaven, so in earth**.

³ Give us day by day our daily bread.

⁴ And forgive us our sins; for we also forgive every one that is indebted to us. And lead us not into temptation; but deliver us from evil.

Luke 11:2-4 New International Version (NIV)

² He said to them, "When you pray, say: *(in the NIV Jesus did not say this?)*

"Father," ^[a] *(whos father?)*

hallowed be your name, *(whose hallowed name are you referring to)*

your kingdom come. ^[b] *(whose kingdom are you referring to)*

³ Give us each day our daily bread.

⁴ Forgive us our sins, *(who are you asking to forgive your sins? It certainly is not Jesus here)*

for we also forgive everyone who sins against us. ^[c]

And lead us not into temptation. ^[d]"

- ❖ NIV comes from a WRONG SPIRIT because it fails the test of not being able to confess that "Jesus Christ is come in the flesh." I John 4:3. NIV I John 4:3 KJV

1 John 4:3 New International Version (NIV)

³ but every spirit that does not acknowledge Jesus is not from God. This is the spirit of the antichrist, which you have heard is coming and even now is already in the world.

1 John 4:3 King James Version (KJV)

³ **And every spirit that confesseth not that Jesus Christ is come in the flesh is not of God: and this is that spirit of antichrist,** whereof ye have heard that it should come; and even now already is it in the world.

- ❖ But every spirit that does not acknowledge Jesus **OMIT** is not from God. This is the spirit of the antichrist. And every spirit that confesseth not that "Jesus Christ is come in the flesh" is not of God, and this is that spirit of antichrist.
 - 1) This is an amazing test for the NIV to fail, because it proves that the NIV comes from a spirit that is not from God.
 - 2) The NIV cannot confess here that "Jesus Christ is come in the flesh".
 - 3) John says that NIV has the spirit of antichrist, as seen by its many omissions of Christ's names, titles and attributes.
 - 4) To merely confess "Jesus", is not passing this test, because Paul warns us of people coming and preaching "another Jesus".
 - 5) Which Jesus are they confessing? They may be confessing a different Jesus - "If he that cometh preacheth another Jesus, whom we have not preached..." (II Corinthians 11:4).

What about Error 4.

- 1) The NIV denies Jesus' VIRGIN BIRTH in Luke 2:33 by stating that Joseph was Jesus' father.
- 2) This denies that God was His Father. If Joseph was Jesus' father, then Jesus inherited a sin nature and He would be unable to save us.
- 3) What a worry if the NIV is true!

³³ **The child's father** and mother marveled at what was said about him.

Luke 2:33 King James Version (KJV)

³³ **And Joseph** and his mother marvelled at those things which were spoken of him.
